

KY Preschool Evaluation System requirements

Full Monitoring- same as P2R including site specific documentation for KY All STARS

First year of the KPES cycle-

- District coordinator or designee will become inter-rater reliable and observe all the classrooms in the district including Head Start blended and contracted sites. This should be completed by the end of the fall semester.
- District submits ECERS 3 scores to their RTC and to KDE
- In the spring, RTCs will observe at least 1/3 of the preschool classrooms at all the sites
- District self-assesses program quality and compliance with preschool regulations, including identifying documents that provide evidence of quality and compliance, then submit this information and the district's self-assessment by June 1st

Mid-Cycle- third year of the KPES cycle

- Submit required district and site specific documents

Annually- Districts submit: Annual Performance Report, Preschool Program Approval, ECERS-3 scores for 1/3 of classrooms with in the district

(every teacher/classroom must have an ECERS-3 by the third year)

- New teacher must have ECERS-3 assessment
- If teacher changes classrooms must have ECERS-3
- New classrooms must have ECERS-3
